#### **Silliman University**

##### *Deepening and Promoting Interreligious and Cultural Understanding towards Peaceable Communities in Mindanao*

Conferences of Christians, Muslims, and Lumads will help generate deeper interreligious and cultural understanding among teachers and students of Silliman University, other church-related schools, and selected churches leaders in Mindanao, as they gain a deeper understanding of each other's cultures, religions, and spiritualities. The participants are also expected to formulate concepts or frameworks to sustaining deeper interreligious and cultural understanding in their communities. The outcome of these outputs will be monitored through area visits. The project will be evaluated based on its goals and specific objectives through the use of Reflecting on Peace Practice (RPP).

#### **Soegijapranata Catholic University**

##### *Intercultural Dialogue and Education in Indonesia: Encountering Social Conflict with Reconciliation and Peace Building Initiative In Law School Curricula*

This project will introduce law school students to alternative dispute resolution models, such as reconciliation and mediation, for settling interreligious/cultural conflicts and developing peace building initiatives. Eight faculties of law will collaboratively write a contemporary book on conflict and conflict settlement, facilitated by Soegijapranata Catholic University, and university partners will try integrating the module into their

educational systems. The program will culminate with a national seminar to disseminate the modules for implementation in different Faculties of Law in Indonesia.
