



**Re: Administrative Fees for Designated Gifts Effective Feb 1, 2023**

For many decades, the United Board has covered the administrative costs of maintaining the high level of service and stewardship provided to donors who choose to work with the United Board to provide donations to support our network institutions. Associated costs for maintaining this program include considerable staff time and resources needed to provide personalized gift planning and staff support services such as receiving, processing and stewarding of such donations. Thus, after careful review and consideration, our Board of Trustees approved the following changes to ensure the sustainability of this valuable service to our network institutions.

Beginning with donations received from February 1, 2023 onwards, the United Board will apply a modest administrative fee to all designated gifts according to the fee schedule below:

The fees will be deducted from the amount sent to recipient institutions and the United Board will follow the same designated gift transfer schedule: *Gifts will be remitted to our network institutions within one month when gifts to an institution accumulate to a total of \$5,000 or more, within three months when gifts accumulate to a total of \$1,000 or more, and within six months when gifts accumulate to a total of \$1,000 or less.*
